Wine Servers Duties

Wine Server Instructions:

Report to Alden Pines Country Club by 1:15 PM dressed in white dress shirts and black pants. Your tables will be set up on the right side of the building.

Meet with Bill Jameson for info on your wine and to receive your black bow tie.

Set up wine station and tools, fill ice buckets with clean ice for glasses as desired, wine, opener, spare plastic cups, water pitcher, cloth napkins and a bucket (for rinsing glasses) You will have a wine cooler for the table as well for the white wines

You should have a small taste of your wine you will be serving to be able to describe it to the guests.

Pour 2 oz. servings of wine for each ticket presented. There will be a 2 oz. glass for measuring & pouring into the guest's wine glass. Patrons will present a card with red & white wine symbols, you will mark off the appropriate wine you serve on their ticket with a magic marker.

Offer a drink water and a rinse of their glass to the guest before each tasting.

Answer guests' questions about the tasting notes provided or refer them to DFV (www.dfvwines.com) or Rob Kiernan (561) 289-8279. You will have an information sheet for your wine on the table.

At the end of the event return all unused wines to Bill Jameson.
