Discussion was made regarding the Co-chairs for the event: Kate Swanstrom, Deb Cundal & for now DJ Ruscik (in the event someone else does not come forward DJ will remain a co-chair)

Discussion regarding how the Silent/Chinese auctions will be handled under one group – Database and soliciting will be organized by Diane Maher and Sonya Leonard. Diane and Sonya will be discussing how to solicit at the next general meeting. – baskets in the storage unit will be sorted and reduced depending on size and quality will determine whether we keep them, donate them or discard them.

This year both auctions will be under the same umbrella and working closely together to make the baskets, soliciting and databases. Discussion regarding kids baskets and having them separate from the rest of the auction in the kids area and also giving each child one or two tickets to enter the auctions as a apart of their entry fee. The idea of doing furniture was discussed and will be determined at a later date.

Discussion on soliciting the donation of Mullet for the fish fry as we were notified that Island Crab Company would no longer be able to help as they no longer employe a mullet fisherman. The ladies in attendance discussed “reaching out” to our contacts who mullet fish to obtain a donation for this year.

Discussion of the adult angler fee increase to \$75/ea and the increase on the payouts. \$2k for the slam/ \$1k for each Red, Snook, and Trout places. Madam stated unless we have a sponsor we will need 66 anglers to cover the pot. (last year we had 68 anglers)

Discussion on fishing rods, sponsors, bikes, and other items were casually discussed.

Discussion for the shirts. We should have the design and shirts available for Mango Mania. Martin Gembecki who originally did artwork for the shirts years ago has agreed to do this years artwork. The artwork will include a characture of our founding madam Nancy Goodwin and incorporate some of the usual items we have on the shirts. The Mariner logo will not be on the sleeve this year but will be replaced with the 20<sup>th</sup> annual and new logo for the fishing tournament that is being designed by S&P designs for us. The new logo will just be for the tournament and used in marketing materials and solociting materials and can be changed for each year to follow.
